





The Zoncolan Experience for ultra-marathon enthusiasts

The 11th edition of the supergirodolomiti is the epitome of an epic cycling adventure: 218 km, 6 Alpine passes, and a staggering 5,060 meters of elevation gain make this ultra cycling marathon one of the toughest challenges in the Alps.

From Lienz in East Tyrol, the route leads through breathtaking mountain landscapes that demand everything –

endurance, willpower, and passion. The highlight awaits at the legendary Monte Zoncolan, that mythical climb that made history in the Giro d'Italia with gradients of up to 22% and produced immortal heroes.

Those who conquer the supergirodolomiti are not just riding a bike race – they are writing their own chapter in the great saga of cycling.

Bicycle service

A service tent will be set up at the start. Furthermore, spare parts and tools for repairs will be available at all refreshment stations. Service vehicles will also be on duty along the route. However, it is advisable to carry spare inner tubes, etc. with you!

Finish refreshments

The finish refreshments will be held in the RGO Arena. There are sufficient toilet facilities and changing rooms. All participants can shower free of charge at the RGO Arena. There will also be plenty of food and drink on offer, including a wide range of meals, cold drinks, and Gösser beer on tap. A well-known band will help to create a great atmosphere.



Team and club ranking

The team classification is only available on the classic Dolomites circuit over 112 km. At least five participants must be nominated for a team, with the four best times being counted. Teams can be registered through a club or by using their own team name. There is a 10% entry fee discount for teams and club registrations (10 or more people).

Scoring categories:

Men's teams
Women's teams
The top 3 teams in each category will receive artistically designed Dolomites trophies!

Time registration

Particularly for the supergirodolomiti, please pay attention to the time limits on the route. At the finish line, the time limit for participants in the classic route is set at 4:30 p.m. and for the supergirodolomiti at 7:30 p.m.

Participants who exceed the set time limits along the route (supergirodolomiti) will be removed from the time recording. These participants have the option of returning to Lienz with the closing vehicles.

Only those participants who have been registered by the start and route control will be recorded in terms of time!

Start mode

Start area: RGO Arena

Access to the start area is via 3 gates (1st block = elite amateur cyclists, 2nd block = well-trained sports cyclists and participants in the "Austria Top Tour" unless they are already in the 1st block. Amateur cyclists can line up in the 3rd block).

Admission to the start for the Supergirodolomiti begins at 5:45 a.m., with the start at 6:30 a.m. Admission to the classic Dolomitenradrundfahrt begins at 8:45 a.m., with the start at 9:30 a.m.

All participants are required to enter the starting area with their race number attached and the transponder attached to their bike (see instructions!). Wearing a helmet is also mandatory when entering the respective starting block!

Traffic information

For the Dolomitenradrundfahrt and the supergirodolomiti, it is essential to comply with the traffic regulations along the entire route. The Dolomitenradrundfahrt and the supergirodolomiti place great importance on the safety of participants and on providing good medical care. The police, with the support of volunteer fire departments, ensure a high level of safety through exemplary monitoring of the route. The rescue system with several Red Cross vehicles and emergency doctors has proven particularly effective on both the Austrian and Italian sections of the route. The use of emergency doctor helicopters is also planned. The use of emergency doctor helicopters is also planned.

Traffic regulations and approved bikes

In addition to road bikes, gravel bikes are also permitted for the Dolomitenradrundfahrt and the Supergirodolomiti. These will be included in the rankings and will receive a certificate with their time and placement. **All participants are subject to Austrian and Italian traffic regulations; the route is not closed to traffic!**

Helmet requirement

Helmets are mandatory! Participants without helmets will be removed from the rankings or not allowed to start.

Liability

Each participant rides at their own risk. By registering, participants confirm that they have liability and accident insurance. Parents are liable for their children. The event organizers, organizers, and sponsors accept no liability for damage or injuries suffered by participants. By registering, participants agree to bear any risks to their person and property arising from the event and not to make any claims against persons, institutions, or companies that are organizing or have organized the event. All participants are advised to take out adequate accident and liability insurance!
