

Traffic information

38th Dolomitenradrundfahrt and 11th SuperGiroDolomiti on Sunday 14 June 2026

Information on the route and traffic restrictions:

On **Sunday, 14 June 2026** at 9.30 am, the starting signal will be given in Lienz for **the 38th Dolomites Cycle Tour** (112 km); participants in **the SuperGiroDolomiti** will set off as early as 6.30 am. During the cycle tour, there will be a number of traffic disruptions and stops along the route:

Route

The start is at the **RGO Arena in Lienz**. The route then heads via the Peggetz junction onto the B100 to Oberdrauburg, over the Gailberg (B110) to Kötschach-Mauthen and through the Lesachtal (B111) to Tassenbach, before returning via the Drautal (B100) to Lienz.

The SuperGiroDolomiti (228 km) takes a longer route over the Plöckenpass into Italy via Paluzza and Ovaro, returning via the Plöckenpass and continuing on the classic route to Lienz.

The fastest riders are expected to reach the finish line at Johannesplatz in Lienz at around 12.30 or 13.30.

The following sections of road will be temporarily closed:

- In Lienz on 14 June, **Franz-Kranebitter-Straße** will be closed, as will the area in the city centre around **Georg-Hauger-Platz, Messinggasse, Kreuzgasse, Rosengasse and Johannesplatz**.
- During the starts on Sunday (14 June) at 6.30 am and 9.30 am, there will be traffic delays in Lienz around **the Peggetz junction** and on **the B100 from Lienz to Oberdrauburg**.
- **The B100 Drautalstraße will be closed** from the Carinthian border to Oberdrauburg from 6.30 am until approx. 7.15 am, and from 9.30 am until approx. 10.45 am.
- The **B110 Plöckenpass Road** will be closed from Oberdrauburg to Kötschach-Mauthen from approximately 6.30 am to 8.00 am and from approximately 9.30 am to 11.15 am
- The **Plöckenpass** between Mauthen and the pass summit is completely closed in both directions from 7.15 am to 1.00 pm.
- The **B111 Gailtal road** in the Lesachtal valley, from Kötschach-Mauthen to Untertilliach, will also be closed on Sunday from 10.00 am to approximately 1.00 pm in both directions.
- Caution is also advised in **the Osttirol Gailtal valley** and on the **B100 between Tassenbach and Lienz**, particularly in the afternoon.
- There may be brief delays along the entire route.

Please follow the instructions of the police and safety officers. The road traffic regulations also apply to the participants of the tour.
